FAQ's

How do I communicate with my camper:

Parents will be provided with a phone number and email address for access to staff at CAA Summit. Additionally, parents are encouraged to drop off notes of encouragement for their campers with CAA staff for distribution throughout the week. Please label with camper's first and last name as well as the day of the week that the note should be delivered to the camper.

Can I send food with my camper:

Food may be sent with your camper, but it must fit the following guidelines/restrictions:

- **No nut ingredients of any kind**
- No fresh fruit or other extremely perishable items
- We would recommend that they don't bring candy/sugary snacks. These are available in the canteen for purchase.
- Suggestions: Cereals, dried fruit, Kind Bars (granola bars with no nuts), seeds (shelled), crackers, etc.

Are electronic devices allowed at camp:

No, please do not send any electronic devices with your child.

What if my child requires medication?

CAA Nurses will meet with parents on Monday morning during drop-off in the *fellowship hall*, and medication will be transported to CAA Summit. Counselors and leadership will be aware of any special medical needs. A camp nurse is available 24 hours per day while at CAA Summit.

What should my child bring to camp:

1. Bedding: Sleeping bag or twin sheets, pillowcases, pillow; towels, toiletries
2. Clothes: Plenty of grubbies (including a change to wear in the mud pit), casual clothes for informal meetings, modest one-piece swimsuit, light jacket, and laundry bag. A pair of long socks for "Domination" and clothes for theme nights: Camo and USA.
3. Shoes: Tennis shoes and hiking or sturdy outdoor shoes, sandals with heel strap and water shoes for the pool if you desire. Several camp activities require closed toed shoes, such as the climbing towers and outpost games. Campers without the proper footwear may not be allowed to participate and/or will do so at their own risk.
4. Money: Cash for snacks, sodas (\$1.00), sport drinks (\$1.25)
5. Medications: Any medications your camper takes or might need to take while at camp. Emergency medical attention is available at all times. Special instructions should be sent to camp for those taking medications or those with special dietary needs.
6. Other items: Flashlight, insect repellent, sunscreen, Bible, pen, journal (if desired)
7. DO NOT BRING electronics, cell phone, snacks, or t-shirts with questionable advertising or sayings.
8. Mark all items with camper's full name.

Are cabins air-conditioned?

No, cabins are not air-conditioned. However, summer temperatures are quite comfortable, especially at night in Brevard. Campers should be very comfortable.

What if my camper becomes ill, is injured, or needs to come home?

If a camper has to be sent home for any reason while at CAA Summit, transportation will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian. If the scope of any injury warrants it, campers will be transported to the local hospital or emergency facility. CAA Summit nurses will be available to assist with any illness or injury at any time.

How does drop off and pick up work?

CAA Summit campers will be dropped off Monday morning in the fellowship hall at Perimeter Church by 9AM. Campers will arrive back to Perimeter Church by 3pm on Friday afternoon and will attend the closing assembly in the main auditorium. Campers will meet back in the fellowship hall to be picked up by parents at 4pm.

What is included in the cost?

CAA Summit costs \$525 per week and includes meals and transportation and all experiences while at Ridge Haven. Campers may bring spending money for canteen items.

What is the staff to camper ratio?

The counselor to camper ratio will be 1:8. CAA leadership (both genders) will also be present.

Discipline Procedure:

1. Warning
2. Sit out of an activity
3. Speak with CORE leader
4. Call home with Director
5. Possible dismissal from camp

*If any camper is dismissed from camp due to behavior issues, they must be picked up at Ridge Haven by a parent or guardian. This applies to campers who are exceptionally sick or homesick as well.
